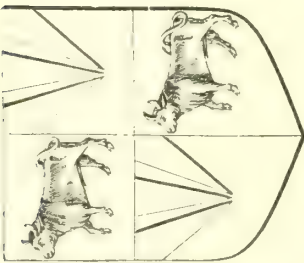

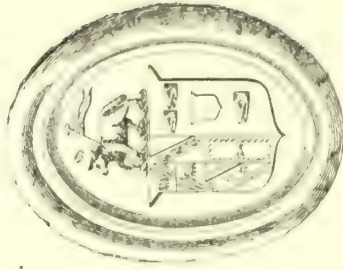

CONFIRMATION OF ARMS TO WILLIAM GEDDES BORRON, OF
SEAFIELD TOWER, ARDROSSAN, 1868.



To all and sundry whom these presents do or may concern, We, George Burnett Esquire, Advocate, Lyon King of Arms, send Greeting. Whereas William Geddes Borron, of Seafield Tower, Ardrossan, in the County of Ayr, Esquire, Merchant and Manufacturer in Glasgow, second son of the late John Arthur Borron, Esquire, Warrington, Lancashire, and Mary Geddes his wife, of the family of Geddes of Rachan, in the County of Peebles, hath by Petition of this date Prayed that We would Grant our License and Authority to him and to his descendants to bear and use such Ensigns Armorial as might be found suitable and according to the Laws of Arms; Know ye therefore that We have devised, and do by these presents Assign, Ratify and Confirm to the said William Geddes Borron, Esquire, and to his descendants with such congruant differences as may hereafter be matriculated for them, the following Ensigns Armorial, as depicted upon the margin hereof, and Matriculated of even date with these presents in Our Public Register of All Arms and Bearings in Scotland; viz. Or a Bull passant Gules, on a chief of the last two Ged's Heads couped of the first. Above the Shield is placed a Helmet befitting his Degree, with a Mantling Gules doubled Argent, and on a Wreath of his Liveries is set for Crest, a Paschal Lamb proper, and in an Escrol over the same this Motto, "PER TELA PER HOSTES IMPAVIDI." In Testimony whereof these presents are subscribed by Us, and the Seal of Our Office is appended hereunto, At Edinburgh, the twentieth day of July in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty eight.
